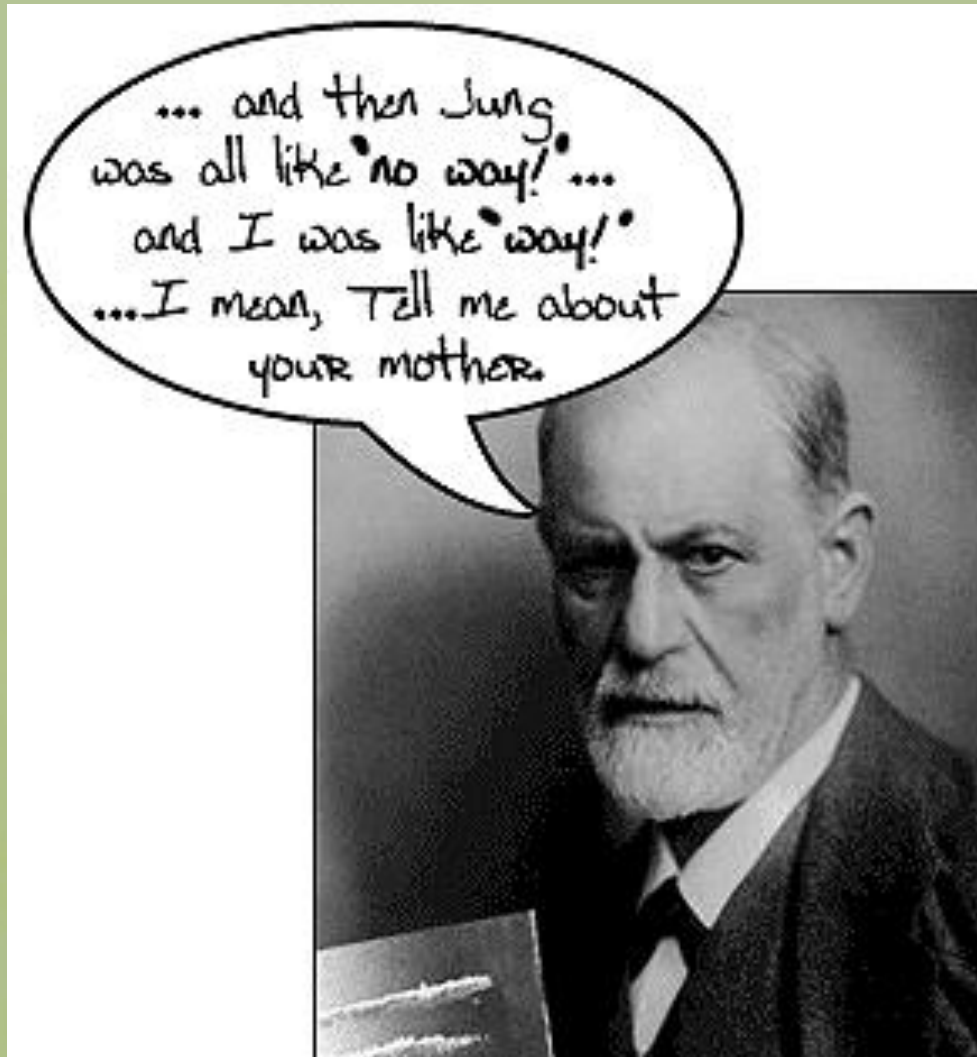

As many of us are becoming increasingly aware, we are in a time of deep change – and now more than ever - are in need of remembering the old ways of connecting to the natural living world around us. Adolfo Ttito Condori, a descendent of the ancient lineage of the Canchi people of the Andes Mountains, is one of only eight altomesayoqs (high shamans) still living in Peru today. He and his brother Rodolfo Ttito Condori, have agreed to come to the United States to teach, to bring the tradition of true indigenous Inca medicine and ritual technology to the West. This lecture and workshop will be a rare opportunity to learn the ancient practice of Incan medicine and cosmology from one of the few authentic Andean masters, here in our community.
